

Background Information



Methodology

Our researchers took 3 weeks in June 2023 and travelled to 10 provinces with Zimbabwe having achieved a significant milestone as a record breaking 6 million individuals have registered to vote in the upcoming 2023 harmonised elections. This number reflects an increase of 500,000 registered voters since the 2018 elections.

- ☐ Face to face interviews with registered voters.
- ☐ A total sample of 3,110 distributed proportionate to voter register.
- ☐ Margin of error + /-2% at 95% confidence level








Intention to Vote in General Elections

Voting intention in August 2023




How likely are you to vote in the upcoming general election?

- The second most popular party is CCC at 34%.








Which political party do you support?



Problems Presidential Candidate Should Address




What are the problems facing this country that a presidential candidate should tackle?



 Mnagagwa is the most preferred candidate to be the President of Zimbabwe.






If elections were to be held today, which presidential candidate would you vote for?
